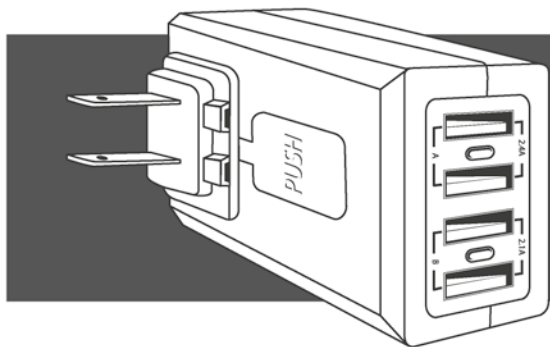

# Cautions

In case of any \*emergency conditions, please unplug the USB Charger from the plug/electric socket.

\*Emergency conditions includes but not limited to:

- Smoke from the unit
- Shape changes
- Liquid or water spill on the charger
- Broken casing or broken parts

1. To prevent Fire and/or Electric Hazards, do not expose the unit to rain or moisture.
2. Please restrict this unit to indoor use only.
3. Do not use the USB Charger with a damaged plug.
4. Children should not be operating the unit without proper supervision.

## Short Circuit Protection

Short circuit breaker helps avoid damages to mobile devices.

## Automatic Voltage Switch ( 100V to 240V )

Multi-Ports USB Charger will automatically detect and switch to the correct voltage no matter which country you are in.

LED light indicates this unit is operating correctly.

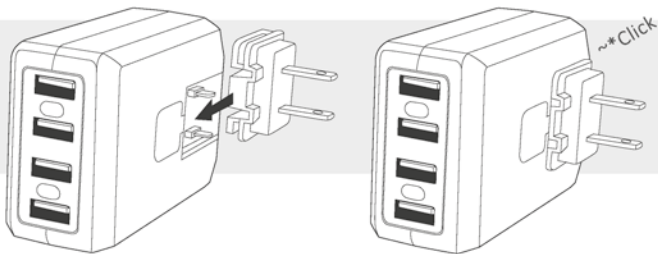

## Troubleshooting

- To shut off power completely you must disconnect/unplug the Multi-Ports USB Charger from its power source.
- Never disassemble the Multi-Ports USB Charger. This unit is a high voltage device and disassembly will invalidate your warranty. It may also cause damage to your devices and possible injury to you.
- Before using this unit, please check the USB ports to ensure there are no foreign objects within the ports.
- While using this unit, be sure that you hold on the sides and keep your fingers away from the metal parts.
- While using this unit, make sure that sufficient airflow is available to prevent the unit from overheating.
- If the unit's connector and the outlet's port do not join smoothly, please check if the connector matches the port and that both ends are correctly aligned. Do not force the unit into the wall outlet.
- Clean this unit with a clean dry cloth. Keeping the metal parts clean helps maintain good performance.
- If the LED status indicator does not light up, make sure that the unit is properly plugged into the wall. If the indicator fails to light up when all connectors/ports are connected correctly, please do not hesitate to contact Digital2's service hotline or visit [www.d2pad.info](http://www.d2pad.info) and click on the support tab for technical support.
- If you experience problems of insufficient charge or failure to charge with this USB power adapter, please check the power consumption rating of your devices. For example, charging an iPhone require at least 5V 1A. A problem will occur when you are simultaneously charging 3 iPhones on this charger. According to the specification, you will only get 0.8A from each USB port with 3 units connected. 0.8A is insufficient to charge an iPhone.

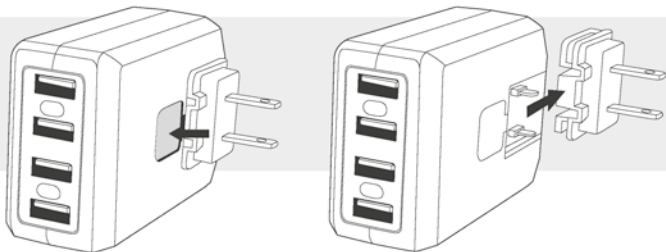
## Installing the AC plug

Prior to using the Multi-Ports USB Adapter, simply insert the AC plug by sliding it into the adapter until a click sound is heard.



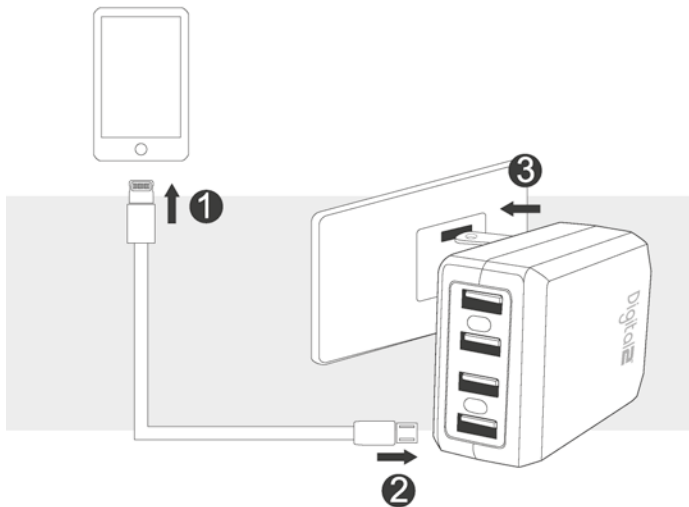
## Removing the AC plug

To remove the AC plug, simply click on the "Push" button and slide the AC plug out from the adapter.



## To Charge

1. Connect your device's USB cable to your device.
2. Connect the USB cable to one of the four USB ports of the USB Adapter.  
\*\*For more output, plug into one of the two ports in Group A.
3. Insert the USB Adapter to the wall power outlet. The LED indicator light will light up.
4. Please disconnect your device from the adapter after charging is complete.



## Warranty

### 90 Days Limited Hardware Warranty

Digital2™ offers a 90 DAYS limited warranty covering the hardware of Digital2™ Tablet Accessories ("Product"), limited to those residing in the 48 continental United States and Canada.

Digital2™ warrants the Product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for NINETY (90) days, as sold to the original purchaser, from the date of retail purchase by the original end-user purchaser. If a hardware defect arises and a valid claim is received within the warranty period, at its option and to the extent permitted by law, Digital2™ will: (1) repair the hardware defect at no charge, using new parts or refurbished parts that are equivalent to new in performance and reliability; or (2) exchange the product with a product that is new or refurbished that is equivalent to new and is functionally equivalent to the original product. This warranty is for replacement for like-items only and does not cover items out of production if the company no longer stocks them. This warranty is not assignable or transferable. Customers are responsible for all replacement shipping charges. Third-party products, such as mobile/ handheld devices, or other peripherals interacting with the Product are not covered by this warranty. Digital2™ is not liable for any 3rd party bundle product(s).

Upon Digital2's replacement or repair of a Product under warranty, the original end-user purchaser will have a remaining warranty of the original warranty period. When a product or part is exchanged, any replacement item becomes your property and the replaced item becomes Digital2's property. Important: Do not disassemble the Product. Disassembling the Product will void this warranty. Only Digital2™ or a party expressly authorized by Digital2™ should perform service on this Product.

This warranty only covers technical hardware issues during the warranty period and under normal use conditions. Digital2™ does not warrant uninterrupted or error-free operation of this Product. This Warranty does not apply to software, environmental, or customer induced damages or circumstances, such as, but not limited to:

- (a) Product has been tampered with, repaired and/or modified by non-authorized personnel;
- (b) Obsolescence;
- (c) Damage (accidental or other) to the Product that is cosmetic, meaning damage that does not impact the operation and functioning of the Product, such as without limitation to rust, change in color, texture or finish, wear and tear, scrapes, dents, cracks, or gradual deterioration;
- (d) Damage to the Product caused by war, terrorism, fire, accident, natural disaster, intentional or accidental misuse, abuse, neglect or improper maintenance, use under abnormal conditions, accidental drops, spills, fire, or power surges;

- (e) Damage to the Product cause by improper installation, connection or malfunction of a peripheral device or connectivity issues (including both hardware and software);
- (f) Fraud, theft, unexplained disappearance or willful act.

Please carefully inspect your Product. As an allowance to original end-user purchasers who receive damaged merchandise due to shipping or handling (for example, cracked Keyboard), Digital2™ may repair or replace the Product, if and only if said purchaser files a claim with Digital2™ within seven (7) calendar days of the original purchase/invoice date. Digital2™ will not accept shipping damage claims: (i) if you purchased the Product in a physical store; (ii) beyond the seven (7) calendar day window; or (iii) if you have an option to pursue a claim with the shipping company (for example, if the Product was insured).

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
